## **Scholarship Rules and Selection Criteria**

### **I. Eligible Degrees:**

Scholarship applicants must be enrolled in, or be seeking enrollment in one of the following courses of study:

1. Bachelor of Science in Surveying;
2. Bachelor of Science in Geomatics;
3. Associate of Applied Science in Surveying Technology;
4. Any degree with a major or curriculum that is substantially the same as those listed.

### **II. Applicant Eligibility Requirements:**

Scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. The applicant must have been a legal resident of the State of North Carolina for the previous twelve months;
2. The applicant must demonstrate a genuine interest in Land Surveying in the State of North Carolina as a profession. This interest may be demonstrated by:
  - a) Successful completion of one academic semester or quarter of college in any of the majors or curriculums listed in Part I, above;
  - b) Work in the field of Land Surveying;
  - c) Completion of an internship in a Land surveying firm;
  - d) Completion of other classes in Land Surveying;
  - e) Attendance at Surveying Camp at an educational institution that has a curriculum in Land Surveying;
  - f) Competition in the high school Trig Star competition;
  - g) Attendance at meetings of the Triangle Chapter of the NCSS;
  - h) Other activities similar to those listed may be submitted to demonstrate interest.
3. The applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better based on a scale of 4.0. For college students who have completed at least two college courses, only the college grade point average applies. For high school students and college students who have not completed two college courses, the high school grade point average applies.

### **III. Required Application:**

A complete application includes:

1. A Triangle Chapter NCCSS Scholarship application;
2. A written statement of your goals, ambitions, interests in Land Surveying and specific intentions upon graduation;
3. A written statement of previous experience in or association with the Land surveying profession. Include any of the items listed in II-2 above that are relevant;
4. Transcripts from your current educational institution or
5. Recommendations from teachers or Professional Land Surveyors.

#### IV. Scholarship Awards:

1. The Triangle Chapter NCSS will evaluate the applications received. A committee appointed by the chapter members will evaluate the applications and award as many scholarships as their discretion dictates.
2. The Triangle Chapter of the NCSS will evaluate the applications on the applicant's grades, degree of demonstrated interest in Land Surveying, recommendations, financial need, and whether the applicant would enhance the Land Surveying profession. The chapter will use its discretion on the weight to be given to each of these areas in evaluating each application.
3. The chapter will notify all applicants of the final status of their application.

#### V. Eligibility Verification:

The Triangle Chapter of NCSS must receive the following:

1. A transcript that includes the school term just completed. For high school students, this would be the final transcript and it must show that the recipient graduated. The transcript must show the GPA specified in II-3 has been maintained;
2. Verification of enrollment in an eligible program at an eligible institution is required;
3. A statement from the recipient of other scholarships or grants accepted. If the amount of the NCSS scholarship plus the amount of the other scholarships exceeds the amount of tuition, fees, books, and room and board, the amount of the NCSS scholarship will be reduced;
4. The Triangle Chapter of NCSS will write the check payable to the institution and mail it to the institution at the address the recipient provides. The letter to the institution will state that the student must maintain a 2.5 GPA and the academic load described in the application for the entire school year.
